



## CONTACT LENS INFORMATION

Microsurgical Eye Consultants is committed to a successful contact lens fitting process for every patient. The following will give you some information needed to proceed.

A contact lens fitting differs from a comprehensive eye exam. To be fit for contact lenses, the provider evaluates many parameters to determine the type of lens that is right for your eyes. This process differs from determining corrective lenses (eye glasses) and from a medical eye exam.

Contact lenses are considered cosmetic and are not a covered service under your health insurance plan. There is an initial consultation and this examination will determine if you are a candidate for contact lenses.

Congratulations if you are a candidate to wear contact lenses! There is a contact lens fitting process and the fee for this is based upon the type of lens the provider has determined that is best for you. Fittings also include a teaching to insert and remove the lenses, a supply of trial lenses, a tutorial on solutions and caring for your lenses, as well as a follow up appointment for the provider to check the fit of your lenses once you have been wearing them. The full amount of the fit package is payable prior to trial lenses being ordered.

Once a prescription for your lenses is finalized and you and the provider are pleased with the fit and vision, we would be happy to order a supply of lenses for you. A contact lens prescription is valid for one year and you will be required to have a yearly contact lens examination to renew your prescription.
